Directions to The Crowne Plaza Resort

From North (Johnson City, TN)

- Travel South on Hwy 19/23 (also known as I-26 East)
- Merge onto I-240 West
- Stay in the right lane as you merge, marked as an "Exit Only" for Exit 3-B (labeled Westgate and Resort Dr)
- Merge into the right lane as you pass the Westgate Shopping Center
- Our driveway is IMMEDIATELY ON THE RIGHT as you round the curve

From South (Asheville Regional Airport; Greenville/Spartanburg, SC; Columbia, SC)

- Travel West on I-26 Follow signs for I-240 to Asheville
- Merge into the left lane and take exit 3A
- This will merge you onto Patton Ave.
- At the 2nd light make a right onto Regent Park Blvd
- The road will bear right and our entrance will be immediately on the left (before entering Sam's Club parking lot)
- Follow our road past our golf course to the main entrance

From East (Hickory, Winston-Salem, Greensboro, Raleigh, NC)

- Travel West on I-40
- Take exit 53-B onto I-240 West towards downtown Asheville
- As you cross the "Jeff Bowen Bridge" merge into the far right lane, marked as an "Exit Only" for Exit 3-B (labeled Westgate and Resort Dr)
- Merge into the right lane as you pass the Westgate Shopping Center
- Our driveway is IMMEDIATELY ON THE RIGHT as you round the curve

From West (Knoxville, TN)

- Travel East on I-40
- Follow signs for I-240 East towards Asheville (left exit)
- Merge into the left lane and take exit 3A

- The road will bear right and our entrance will be immediately on the left (before entering Sam's Club parking lot)

Policy on Standard of Behavior by ABTC Members Attending National (and other) Specialty Shows

The ABTC has an excellent history of maintaining its Specialty headquarters and show site in good condition. Rings, grooming areas and hotel rooms occupied by its members are expected to be left with no appreciable damage, and as clean as possible, after the Specialty is over. As a measure of insuring that this standard will be met, the Club, as a matter of policy sets forth the following standards of behavior.

1. No dogs should be left uncrated in a hotel room in the absence of the room occupants at any time.
2. Dogs that constitute a nuisance to other occupants of the hotel by continual barking or howling, may subject their owners to being removed by the hotel.
3. There will be **no** grooming of dogs in the hotel rooms. Grooming will be permitted only in the areas set aside for that purpose.
4. No Dogs should be washed in hotel bathtubs and hotel towels should not be used on dogs for drying them or any other purpose.
5. The external and internal premises of the hotel and show site shall be kept free of debris and feces caused by the presence of dogs attending the Specialty.
6. The Club will provide a committee to inspect rooms upon member checkout, either separately from, or in concert with, designated members from the hotel staff. Should any room or its contents exhibit signs of unusual wear or damage because of the presence of a dog or dogs, the occupant of that room may be held up to censure by the Club and shall recompense the hotel for all damages. Offenders may be censured, held in suspension of membership or expelled from membership in the ABTC should the circumstances warrant.
7. While the ABTC cannot assume legal responsibility for the actions of individual persons attending one of its national specialties, it does assume ethical responsibility for their actions. it will make every effort to assure that any offending person make redress to the hotel or show site in the event that he/she is responsible for damage to the premises.
8. The ABTC urges its members to carefully inspect their rooms prior to checkout.

All members of the ABTC are expected to adhere to these Standards.

The Specialty Committee additionally requires that:

1. Exhibitors are not to bring litters of puppies to the Show Headquarters.
2. Non-ABTC members attending the 2017 National Specialty will adhere to these standards.
3. All dogs will be on a leash at all times.

By exhibiting at the National Specialty, you are agreeing to abide by the rules established by the show committee and the host hotel. Failure to follow these rules will result in removal from the host hotel.
